Registration at Parker's Central Park and Tackle [Mishawaka] or at Captain Cook's [New Buffalo], no later than 6:00 pm the night before the tournament [Friday]. **Entry fee must be paid in cash, NO CHECKS.**

There will be a shotgun start out of all three ports you are allowed to fish out of. These are Michigan City, New Buffalo, and St. Joe. All boats must remain within ¼ mile of the pier heads before the start. There will be an appointed boat at each port to verify the shotgun start is at 6:00 AM Eastern Daylight Time. Fishing time ends at 1 PM, Weigh-In is at 2 PM at New Buffalo. 9 ROD LIMIT!!!

All DNR RULES APPLY

Weigh in your 5 heaviest Fish (only 1 lake trout is allowed)

100% Payout, First Place 40%, Second Place 30%, Third Place 20%, Fourth Place 10%
Big Fish 100% of Big Fish Pot.

10 points per fish and 1 point per pound. Ties will be broken by heaviest fish.

Weigh-In location is at The New Buffalo Pavilion next to the public boat launch.

You may fish out any of the following ports Michigan City, New Buffalo, or St. Joe.

You must be checked at the Weigh-In by 2 PM or you will be disqualified.
